## **APPLICATION**

Was your family living in the Town of Greece before 1872? If you have documentation that proves that fact, then you can apply for a PIONEER CERTIFICATE from the Greece Historical Society by submitting the following three items:

- 1) this completed application form
- 2) a Six-generation PEDIGREE CHART (or you can submit a chart generated by your own genealogy program (e.g., Ancestry, Family Tree Maker, My Heritage) that traces you back to the Greece pioneer generation. Please be aware that you only need to fill in the maternal -orpaternal side, whichever one takes you back to your pioneer Greece ancestor. If you are applying for a certificate for two different surnames, then you will need to provide the relevant pedigree chart for each eligible surname.
- 3) attach any additional relevant document (your family in an 1870 Greece census or earlier, a birth, baptism or death certificate from Greece, event, etc.) that proves that your pioneer ancestor was living in the Town of Greece by 1872. (Yes, it must be enumerated in the town, not the City of Rochester)
