Fire Partly Destroys Greece School No. 5

First alma mater of scores of Rochesterians now active in professional and business life, Greece District School No. 5, standing on the summit of what is known as "Paddy's Hill," Latta Road and Mt. Read Boulevard, gave up its ghost yesterday to flames of undetermined origin.

The blaze burned off the rear of the frame building and swept most of the interior. What is left is expected to be torn down. Damage was set at \$5,000.

Firemen of the North Greece Fire Department, responding to the alarm, found flames leaping from the rear of the building and eating toward the front. They extinguished them after a brief fight
